



City council holding public hearing

Local sales tax revenue remains strong

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced last week he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose districts \$1.07 billion in local sales tax allocations for January, 7.6 percent more than in January 2022. These allocations are based on sales made in November by businesses that report tax monthly.

And Gladewater and White Oak are experiencing this growth. Gladewater is riding a 16-month increase over last year - 4.77-percent - and White Oak is seeing a jump of 25.35-percent over the same reporting period a year ago.

Only Clarksville City posted a decline in local sales tax revenue among Gregg County cities.

30,000,000 Texans

The Texas population now tops 30 million according to recent estimates from the US Census Bureau. In fact, the state added 470,708 people (measured from July 2021 to July 2022), the largest-gaining state in the nation. Growth in Texas last year was fueled by gains from all three



(118,159). That's a lot of new Texans (almost 1,300 every day)!

and Illinois also had six-figure decreases.

Moves around the United States accounted for a notable component of the changes. The biggest gains from net domestic migration last year were in Florida (318,855), Texas (230,961) and North Carolina (99,796). The biggest losses

were in California (-343,230), New York (-299,557) and Illinois (-141,656).

People choosing to move to Texas reflects a range of factors, from the dynamic economy to greater affordability. With companies locating and expanding and the likelihood that the state will outperform most areas, we can expect to continue to attract new residents from other parts of the

country and the world. At the same time, a younger popula-


tion contributes to the natural growth rate.


Schools will need to expand. According to data from the Texas Education Agency, total enrollment in Texas public schools increased by nearly 429,000 students (8.6%) over the past 10 years, and many schools are crowded. In addition, nearly 61% of all students are identified as economically disadvantaged and the number is rising (up by some 56,000 over the last year). The percentage of students identified as emergent bilingual students/English learners is also growing and now approaches 22%. Both of these groups may require additional resources in the classroom and are critical to our future workforce.

Accommodating the substantial population expansion expected in the decades to come will also require investing in infrastructure of all types – highways, broadband, electric transmission and distribution, pipelines, and water delivery systems. The key is to try to get ahead of (or at least stay with) the increases to avoid eroding quality of life for all.

With the right investments in education and infrastructure, we can keep Texas a great place to live and work. We have the resources. It's time to step up! Stay safe!

Speaker open to resort-style casinos in state

House Speaker Dade Phelan, R-Beaumont, told The Dallas Morning News and other media outlets that he is open to bringing resort-style casinos to Texas. But don't expect to find slot machines in 7-Eleven stores if casino gambling is legalized.

"What I don't want to see is to walk into every convenience store and see 15 slot machines," Phelan said. "I want to see destination-style casinos that are high quality and that create jobs and that improve the lifestyle of those communities."

The gambling industry is preparing for another strong push to bring gaming to one of the few major markets that doesn't allow it. But other state leaders seem more hesitant, including Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick, who said in December that he "doesn't see any movement on it."

Gov. Greg Abbott has softened his once-strong opposition to legalized gambling, echoing Phelan's support for casinos that also feature golf courses, luxury hotels and other amenities.

The Morning News report said the Dallas-Fort Worth area would be a top location because of its strong convention and tourism industry, as well as access to major airports.

House rules allow Democrats to chair committees

New House rules adopted in the first week of the legislative session allow the appointment of Democrats to chair certain committees, despite being in the minority in that chamber. The Texas Standard reported that was a victory for Phelan, who defied Republicans wanting to ban Democrats from holding chair positions.

In Phelan's first speech after being reelected speaker, he talked about the importance of both parties working together.

"After watching Congress attempt to function last week, I cannot imagine why some want Texans to be like D.C.,' Phelan said, referring to the protracted battle over electing a U.S. Speaker of the House.

Another provision is aimed at stopping legislators from skipping sessions to break quorum by levying fines every day they are absent without leave. During the 2021 session, House Democrats left Texas for 38 days in an ultimately unsuccessful attempt to block passage of a slate of voting restrictions.

Wildfire danger returns to state

A series of dry cold fronts sweeping through the next this week bring the potential of increased wildfire risk to parts of the state, according to the Texas A&M Forest Service. On Jan. 11, the service responded to five requests for assistance on wildfires that burned more than 740 acres across the state. The largest of these was the Cellers Hill Fire in Throckmorton County.

As of Sunday, the only active blaze was the 23-acre Grub Hill Fire in Wise County, which was 90% contained.

Currently, 69 counties are under burn bans.

Prisoners launch hunger strikes over solitary confinement

A large-scale hunger strike protesting the state's solitary confinement practices began last Tuesday, with about 300 people in Texas prisons reportedly participating, according to the Texas Standard. The prisoners are protesting the state's practice of placing inmates in solitary indefinitely.

Michele Deitch, director of the Prison and Jail Innovation Lab at the University of Texas at Austin, said prisoners have gone on hunger strikes to push the Texas Department of Criminal Justice to meet months-long demands for change. Besides ending indefinite solitary confinement, also called restrictive housing, the prisoners want to move to a behavioral-based system rather than a status-based system. Under the latter, prisoners can be placed in solitary simply by being labeled a gang member, not necessarily for breaking any rules.

"I do believe that it is something that the agency should take a very hard look at, whether there are ways that they could be approaching this issue that are both safe and more appropriate," Deitch told the Standard.

From La Niña to El Niño? Possibly

The 2022 drought didn't turn out to be as severe as that of 2011, but it still caused widespread economic damage to crops and livestock, as well as shrinking water-supply reservoirs. As the state heads into 2023, Dr. Mark Wentzel, hydrologist with the Texas Water Development Board, is among forecasters predicting an end to the conditions that resulted in reduced rainfall and warmer temperatures for the last few years.

"The National Weather Service is expecting that La Niña will dissipate, and then, possibly by the summer to next fall, we might actually be in El Niño conditions, the opposite to La Niña. And those conditions (could) actually bring Texas a wetter and cooler winter than is normal," Wentzel wrote.

The most severe drought now is centered in the Texas Hill Country, in Kendall and surrounding counties, and in the extreme northern boundary of the Texas Panhandle. Drought conditions have ended in East and Southeast Texas.

Wentzel wrote he expects "some easing" of drought conditions this spring.

Wildlife vaccine bait airdrop underway

The Texas Department of State Health Services has renewed its battle against rabies along the Texas border by

airdropping vaccine bait from planes leaving Edinburg, Del Rio and Alpine.

"Our goal is to vaccinate wildlife, with target species being coyotes and gray foxes, along the border to maintain herd immunity and to keep past variants from being reintroduced or new variants from entering Texas," said Dr. Susan Rollo,


director of the Oral Rabies Vaccination Program. "We will be delivering vaccine baits to 18 counties this year."

About 814,000 oral rabies vaccine baits will be dropped in the 29th year of the program.

COVID-19 cases rise slightly

New cases of COVID-19 in Texas in the past week rose to 35,632 with 148 deaths, according to the Coronavirus Resource Center at Johns Hopkins University. DSHS reported 3,427 lab-confirmed COVID-19 patients in Texas hospitals, also an increase.





Upshur hears update on courthouse project

Upshur County Commissioners Court on Friday heard an update on progress on the forthcoming historical renovation of the county courthouse in Gilmer, a multi-million dollar project which will result in courthouse offices temporarily moving to another site for possibly up to two years.

Marion County Judge Leward J. LaFleur, who the court hired last year to oversee the project after his own county's courthouse in Jefferson underwent such a renovation, joined a representative of Komatsu Architecture, Rick Sacy, in briefing the court.

The project, designed to restore the five-story brick courthouse largely to its interior appearance when it was completed in 1937, will be financed by state, county and federal funds. Offices will temporarily move to the nearby former Gilmer ISD administration building, which the county recently leased from the school for \$1 annually for three years.

"We're still shooting on being out of here (by the) end of March," County Judge Todd Tefteller said, and LeFleur agreed. LaFleur said he didn't know when construction would actually begin, but estimated it would start in "late summer,

Sacy explained that the bidding process for the project will take weeks, and detailed other steps to be taken before actual construction begins. After the meeting, he told The Mirror he estimated the building will be vacated 20-24 months. (At one point, it had been estimated that could take up to three years.)

Sacy said "my goal is to be through with" certain documents, to be sent to the state government for final approval, by early April. He expressed hope approval would be granted

He also updated the court on floor plans and pledged to "make

sure everything is exactly where it should be." Sacy said he would meet with a civil engineer, then meet with other engineers (such as plumbing) and have the court tell him

how it wants to seek bids. For example, he said, one option would be for the court to hire a contractor, who would take the bids. The court would decide after the state gives final approval to certain documents, said

Sacy, who worked on the Marion County project. When Precinct 3 Commissioner Michael Ashley said completing the pre-construction process sounded like it was at least four months away, LeFleur said, "It depends on my mechanical,

electrical, plumbing" and other engineers. As some of the plans for the project were drawn up years ago, LaFleur said 30% of them are now "worthless." Still, Sacy assured the court that completing the preliminary work is "not far off. Trust me."

Tefteller had recently said he expected construction workers to be "swinging hammers" by April, but LaFleur said the timetable is "a little more fluid" than that. The construction overseer said some plans must be "re-modified to fit today's standard," and Sacy added compliance with the city of Gilmer's building code must be ensured.

"Not every contractor can do these" types of work involved in the project, he cautioned. He said those doing the finishes, carpentry, new railings and windows must have at least 20 years experience at it.

Explaining how the building will appear, Sacy said, "This looks like 1938 when you walk in it, but it's a 21st century

Upshur County Commissioners Court, at its first meeting of 2023 Friday, held a closed session on two matters without taking any votes afterward.



Texas farmers, ranchers help set national farm policy for 2023

Texas Farm Bureau (TFB) voting delegates at the American Farm Bureau Federation (AFBF) annual meeting in Puerto Rico successfully supported nearly 20 policy resolutions from the Lone Star State into new AFBF national policy.

The 28 TFB voting delegates were among the 341 voting delegates from 50 Farm Bureaus and the Puerto Rico Farm Bureau at the annual meeting's Jan. 10 business session.

"We had a really good day on our resolutions. It was good discussion," TFB President Russell Boening said. "The ideas that passed today go into our national policy book, and it gives us leaders and staff of American Farm Bureau a roadmap to work on the next farm bill, to work on policies that affect us on the regulatory issues."

TFB policy resolutions adopted by AFBF voting delegates

included support for a limited irrigation category in the RMA crop insurance program, support for a stock tank/farm pond clean out program and support for efforts to allow livestock market owners to invest in ownership of small, very small and regional meat packing and processing facilities.

Other TFB policy resolutions adopted at the meeting included support for increased funding for feral hog control programs and pilot projects in the farm bill; opposition to any foreign entity or persons receiving tax credits, abatements, incentives or any other in-kind contribution that affects the taking of agricultural land in the U.S.; and opposition to any form of a Securities and Exchange Commission ruling that would require emissions reporting that could directly or indirectly impact farmers and ranchers.

AFBF voting delegates also approved a TFB policy resolution regarding taxation that supports deferring recognition of income for one year for all or a percentage of crop insurance or indemnity payments.

"I think the mood of the delegate body was good. There is excitement about the new farm bill. At the same time, there is cautious optimism, because there is a lot of talk of climate change, climate-smart practices, sustainability, different terms like that, that get thrown around. And folks are just a little bit concerned about how those issues are going to play into the farm bill, but I think our policy is ready to address those issues," Boening said.

In other business, Boening, who farms and ranches in South Texas, was re-elected to the AFBF board of directors.

Kilgore College Rangerettes, but with rumors of war, she decided to move to Dallas for a short time and get her dance degree and teach. By the time she got home, World War II had begun and no one could afford dance lessons. A friend who owned a grocery store asked if she could work for him since most of the men had been called to war.

She met the love of her life Tom Sawyer while she was working for the USO as President. USO would hold activities and dances for the service men who were coming home from the war. They were married in March 1945. 9 months later the first of 6 children were to bless this union. Tommy, Ronnie (deceased), Jan, Karen, Annette and Patti, all graduates of Gladewater High. Ernestine spent many a year as room mother, Catechism teacher at her beloved Catholic Church, Saint Theresa's. She was an excellent seamstress, creating many a cheerleader, majorette and Honey Bear costume. Along with many prom, bridesmaid and wedding dresses for her family and friends. Years later she would be part of the original group that created the Gladewater Former Students Association where she is a Kodiak Bear member.

She lived in the little house on Gay Avenue from 1953 until recently when she move in with her daughter.


