AN ORDINANCE OF THE GLADEWATER CITY COUNCIL, AMENDING §5.03.150 SOLID WASTE SCHEDULE OF FEES; §17 FEE SCHEDULE: 17.03 ADMINISTRATION, 17.09 BUILDING/INSPECTION, 17.11 CEMETERY, 17.13 LAKE, AND 17.17 WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE GLADEWATER CODE OF ORDINANCES AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

## 5.03.150 Schedule Of Rates

Upon the first billing cycle following May 1, 2021, Allied Waste has exclusive franchise rights within the City service area.

A. Commercial containerized cart rates. Upon the first billing cycle following October 25, April 1, 2025, the rates for commercial containerized garbage pick-up service shall be \$32.1323.57 and \$9.456.93 30 for each additional cart.

- C. Residential rates. Upon the first billing cycle following Octonrt 25, April 1, 2025, the rates for residential garbage pick-up service will be twenty dollars and zero cents (\$20.00) sixteen dollars and seventy-four cents (\$16.74) per month.
- D. Outside city residential rates. A rate of one-and-one-half (1 1/2) times the inside residential rate will be charged to those customers outside the corporate limits of the City of Gladewater, Texas.
- E. Additional poly cart fee: A fee of \$12.006.93 per month will be charged for each additional poly cart provided.
- F. Special pick-ups. The rates for special pick-ups (Section 13.01B of the contract) shall be \$74.2254.45 minimum and an hourly charge of \$74.2254.45.
- G. Fee adjustments. Any proposal to adjust fees for the services outlined in Parts A–E shall be considered annually by the City Council based on the CPI All Urban Consumers (Water, Sewer and Trash Collection Services), U.S. City Average, as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Statistics. Any request to raise fees shall be made at least 60 days before the contract anniversary date pursuant to Section 13.02 of the contract.

**SECTION 9: EFFECTIVE DATE** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from September 18, 2025 and after the required approval and publication according to law.
